

- books, documents;
- alcoholic beverages – 19 bottles;
- laptop (color: black);
- gold (a few necklaces, an icon);
- money over 5,000 hryvnas;

a car [REDACTED] was also seized. They returned to the checkpoint in two cars and handed [REDACTED] over to 3rd platoon commander “Piter.” It has been confirmed that “Luka” later returned to the metal warehouse and seized a vintage rifle.

The investigation has revealed that “Luka” and “Bolgar” were not honest with the inspection officers. Knowing that [REDACTED] was in the cellar, they tried to mislead inspection officers “Nos,” “Lyolik,” and “Zubr” in order to illegally detain [REDACTED] in the cellar. [REDACTED] was discovered and freed by the inspection officers at 17:00. According to “Zubr,” [REDACTED] had been tortured: he was hanging from the ceiling by his hands, there was a bag on his head.

[REDACTED], born on [REDACTED] in Russia; resident address: [REDACTED] Slovyansk; no previous convictions; a businessman who helps the DNR as a passive and non-public supporter; he is popular with the residents of Slovyansk and is an intelligence agent of [REDACTED] who had been looking for him and asked “Bolgar” for any information, but received none.

Marauding and illegal detention and confinement of [REDACTED] undermines the authority of the officers of the National Liberating Movement of the DNR.

This incident was a result of low control by unit commander “Balu” over his subordinates.

In view of the facts stated above:

1. The investigation of the illegal activities against [REDACTED] is considered completed.
